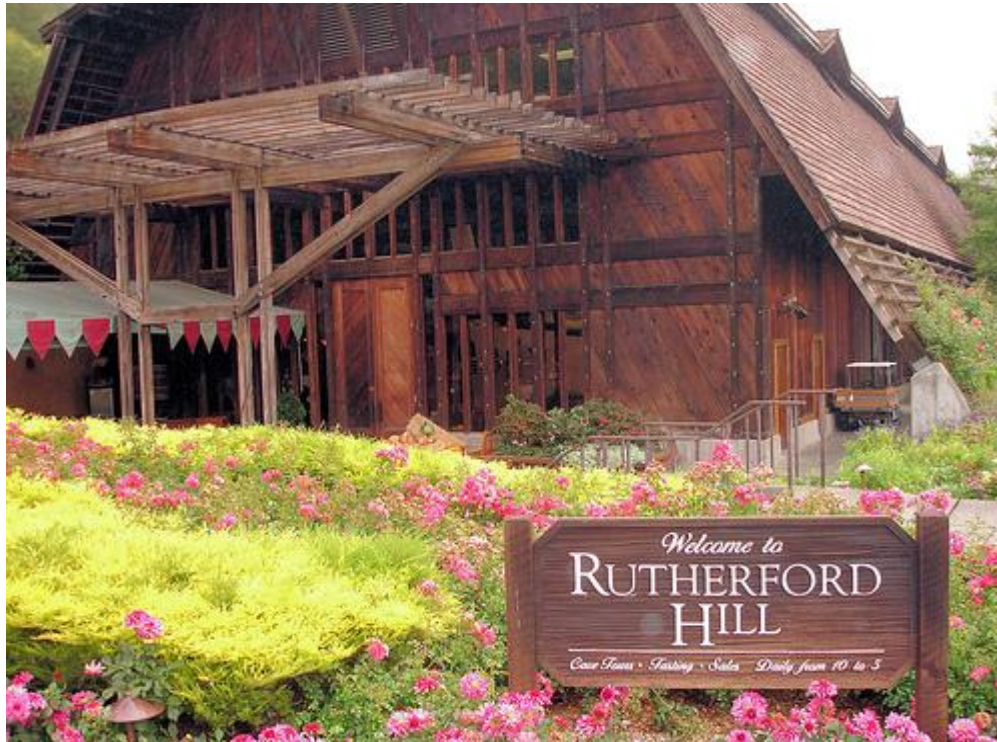

Chimney Rock Winery was established in 1980 with the goal of creating wines that would compete against the best of Bordeaux. Today that goal is pursued with renewed passion by wine-industry pioneer Anthony J. Terlato and his sons, Bill and John.

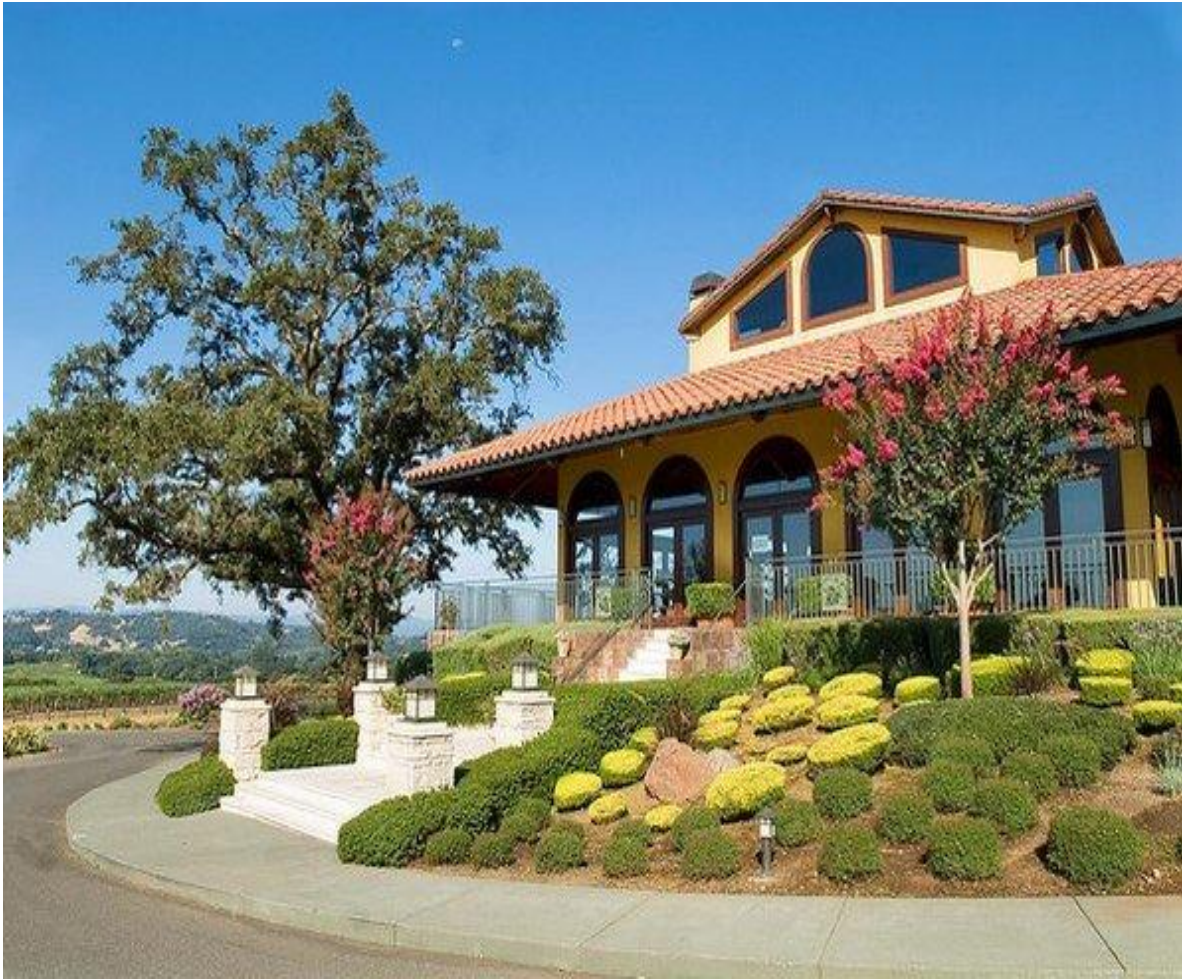
The distinctive character of Chimney Rock's wines springs from a simple yet extraordinary foundation: The Stags Leap District, Napa Valley's smallest and, arguably, most acclaimed sub-appellation. All the grapes for Chimney Rock's Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Sauvignon and "Elevage" are grown on the winery's 137-acre estate at the southern end of the District. Winemaker Doug Fletcher captures the estate's unique terroir through his innovative and meticulous approach to vineyard management. As a result, the wines are impeccably balanced, with full ripe fruit and silky tannins.

Another change came when the winery moved from the more traditional heavy cabernets to the release of two highly acclaimed wines, a Merlot and a Chardonnay, in the mid-1980s. Many accolades for these highly rated, affordable wines followed and today the winery produces 65,000 cases, mostly Chardonnay. Facilities include a wine cave and pleasant picnic area.

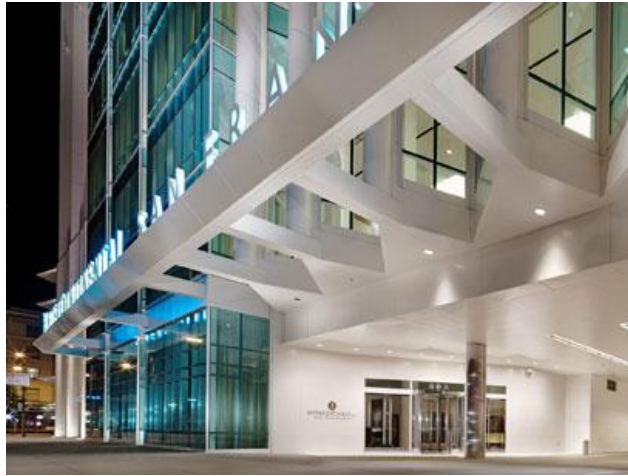

ALCATRAZ TOUR

“The Dark Side of The Rock”

Only one thing was worse than living on Alcatraz: living there at night! Get an idea of existence in the cold and dark cell houses of Alcatraz. It’s the closest way to replicate the feeling of The Rock’s isolation after sundown.

The Night Tour is a unique program limited to just a few hundred visitors per evening that includes special programs, tours and activities not offered during the day.

Roundtrip ferry transportation, the Cell House audio tour, a keepsake souvenir brochure, recreation use fee, and a variety of special programs and presentations offered only at night are all included.

Be sure to dress warm – it gets cold after dark.

Popular with tourists and sea lions, Fisherman's Wharf is full of shops, silly museums and family fun. Still a working wharf, its vendors sell thousands of tons of fish and shellfish. Take an early morning walk down "Fish Alley" to see fisherman at work. Later, the Wharf is boardwalk-style family entertainment with decidedly tourist attractions such as Ripley's Believe It or Not! Museum, the Red & White Fleet, a the Wax Museum. For maritime-lovers and WWII buffs, the San Francisco Maritime Museum is at the foot of Polk St. and massive USS Pampanito is docked right at Pier 45.



CHINATOWN

CHINATOWN, Italian North Beach and the old Barbary Coast are the most beloved, fun-filled, storied and wicked neighborhoods in San Francisco. The tour begins at the famous Chinatown Gate.
